Dear Hotel Owners and Managers,

Beginning July 1, 2023, the Monterey County Tourism Improvement District (MCTID) assessment is increasing. On February 21, 2023, the City of Monterey City Council, serving as the lead jurisdiction for renewing the MCTID, approved an increase to the assessment per City Council Resolution No. 23-019 C.S. Hotel operators are to collect, from the transient guests, \$7.00 per paid occupied room per night for luxury lodging businesses, \$4.50 per paid occupied room night for non-luxury full-service lodging businesses, and \$1.50 per paid occupied room night for limited-service lodging businesses.

** The MCTID assessment was approved for a ten (10) year term through June 30, 2033. The rate shall automatically increase biennially beginning in FY 2025-26. The assessment increase shall be \$0.90 per paid occupied room per night for luxury lodging businesses, \$0.60 per paid occupied room per night for non-luxury full-service lodging businesses, and \$0.20 per paid occupied room per night for limited-service lodging businesses.



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If you are remitting a payment via check, we kindly ask that you use the most current *forms found on the City of Marina Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) website portal*. Using these forms will assist you in the calculations and ensure the correct exemptions to those who are eligible per the *Marina Municipal Code*.

Beginning with the month of July, TOT returns, due August 31, the City and HdL, serving as the administrator of the City of Marina's TOT program, will only accept the updated exemption forms. Links are included below for your convenience.
